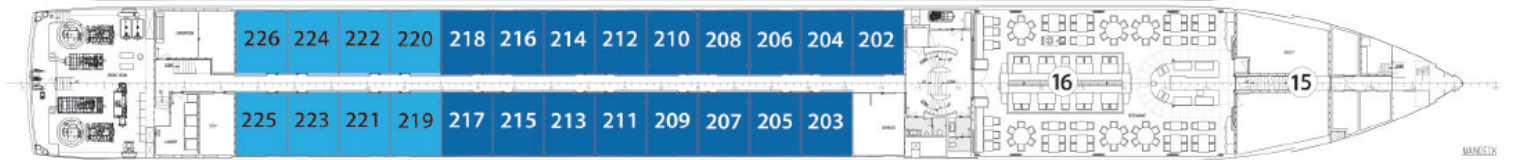

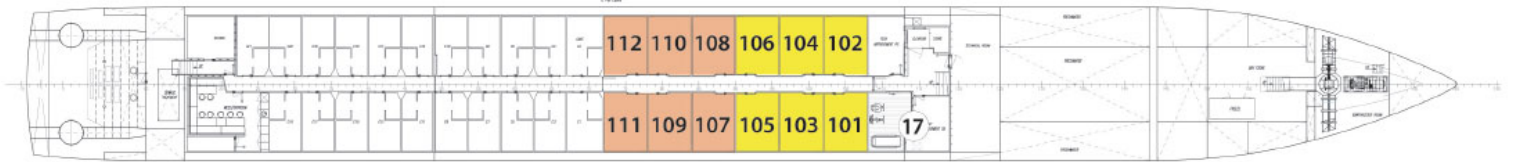

**PAYMENT INFORMATION: A NON-REFUNDABLE** deposit of \$350.00 per person along with the reservation coupon is due at time of booking (Single Occupancy will require \$600 per person). All categories are subject to availability at time of booking. **FINAL PAYMENT IS DUE NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, JULY 16, 2021.**

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION:** Any changes made to your reservation once deposit has been received will be subject to a fee at the discretion of the airline and/or cruise line.

**PAYMENTS:** You may charge any portion or the entire amount on your Boscov's Charge, Master Card or Visa. If paying by check, make it payable to Boscov's Travel.

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** Round trip air transportation is included between Philadelphia and Paris, France (including air taxes, government fees and fuel surcharges, which are subject to change at the discretion of the airline).
