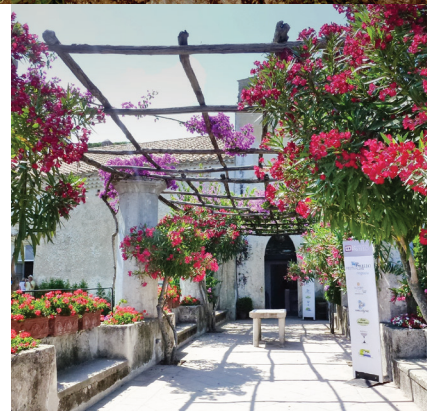


TOUR *highlights*



Booking Conditions: Every endeavor is made to ensure all services are included as per outlined. Supplementary charges may be applied. All itineraries offered are subject to local driver regulations. It is the Travel Director's duty to ensure that driver's regulations are not broken. Please be aware that public holidays, events, conferences or trade fairs may be scheduled to occur at the time of the groups visit and may have an effect on this tour with accommodations often difficult to secure in and around the area. We will update you on these events as they become available.

Deposit & Final Payment: Deposits are due with Reservation Form to secure reservations. Non-refundable deposit amounts are as follows: 2026-05-10 tour \$300 per person; 2026-08-07 tour \$450 per person; 2026-10-02 tour \$300 per person; 2026-11-07 tour \$450 per person. Final Payment Due Date is 100 days prior to departure. Additional deposits may be required by particular hotels which we secure for the tour. As they become known you will be invoiced accordingly, and payment conditions specified.

Air Transportation: is not included in price shown.

Name Changes: are not allowed. Each passenger cancellation is processed independently of any new passenger booking.

***Rates:** Rates are per person based on double occupancy. Rates are subject to availability at time of booking. Prices are based on charges, taxes and levies current at the time of booking and may change if there are significant changes in taxes, charges or levies imposed by any government or its agencies. The price is based on minimum passenger numbers and in order for the tour to operate these passenger numbers must be met.

Triple rooms may be available on selected vacation in limited numbers. Triple or quad occupancy rooms may utilize rollaway beds and three adults may find these rooms small.

Required Travel Documentation: For travel within the United States, a valid government issued photo identification will be required (i.e. valid driver's license). Beginning May 7, 2025, a Real ID will be required for air travel within the United States. A VALID PASSPORT BOOK is required for tours that leave the United States even to Canada and is the responsibility of each passenger. A passport card cannot be used for international air travel. Passport books should be valid for up to six (6) months beyond the return date of travel. All names must be submitted exactly as they appear on passenger passports. Dates of Birth (DOB's) are required with reservation for air travel. A clear and readable copy of passports is required. Additional forms may be necessary based on the destination.

Itinerary: Itinerary is subject to change. It's very common for the daily activities and people to people interactions & visits to be interchanged and experienced on different days than this printed itinerary. All visits and experiences will be included as written in this itinerary, but could be on different days due to availability and schedules.
