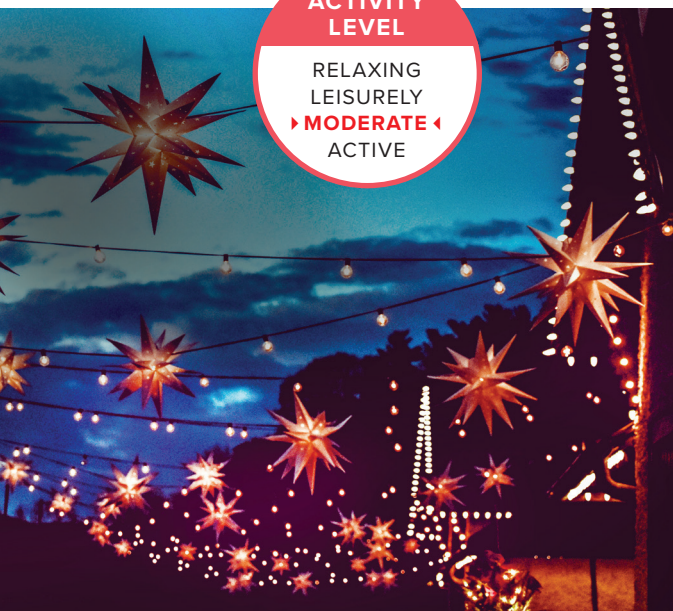

DAY 1: CHARLOTTE, NC - ASHEVILLE, NC This morning, fly into Charlotte, North Carolina where you will be met by your Unique Journeys Tour Director. DAY 2: ASHEVILLE, NC - CITY TOUR - CANDLELIGHT CHRISTMAS EVENING AT BILTMORE ESTATE After breakfast, you will head downtown where you will meet your local guide for a driving tour of Asheville. Your guide will relate to you the history of Asheville, and tell you about some of the remarkable people who settled here. Among the things you will see are the Basilica of St. Lawrence, the River Arts District, the quaint and historic Biltmore Village, and the Asheville Folk Art Center on the Blue Ridge Parkway, home to the Southern Highland Craft Guild. The center showcases the finest in traditional and contemporary crafts of Southern Appalachia. After your tour, you will have leisure time at the Grove Arcade for lunch on your own and shopping. In the afternoon, you will return to the hotel for a chance to relax and freshen up before this evening’s events. Dinner is included this evening at a local restaurant. Following dinner, you will be transferred to the Biltmore Estate for a Candlelight Christmas Evening. At the Biltmore, you will enjoy a self-guided audio tour of the mansion, richly decorated for the holidays and filled with candlelight and music, just as it was when George Vanderbilt first opened Biltmore to his family and friends on Christmas Eve in 1895. 🚶 B, D 🏠 Asheville, NC

DAY 3: ASHEVILLE, NC - BILTMORE ESTATE - NC ARBORETUM’S WINTER LIGHTS Following breakfast at the hotel this morning, you will return to Biltmore Estate to visit the Gardens, Conservatory, and Antler Hill Village. First, you have a reserved timed admission to the spectacular new exhibition, “King Tutankhamun: His Tomb and His Treasures.” This exciting exhibition is an unforgettable exploration of the culture of ancient Egypt, the time of Tutankhamun, the search for and thrilling discovery of his tomb, and the

The event, hailed as the world's most complete Tutankhamun exhibition, becomes all the more fascinating in its Biltmore presentation—this is the only experience that reveals the historical connections between the monumental discovery and the Vanderbilt-Cecil family. Following the exhibit you will have free time to visit the shops at Antler Hill Village, Biltmore Winery (wine tasting included), the Conservatory, and Gardens. Lunch is on your own here today. Dinner this evening is included at Stone Ridge Tavern. After dinner, you'll be filled with the holiday spirit as you visit *Winter Lights* at the North Carolina Arboretum. DAY 4: ASHEVILLE, NC - MAST GENERAL STORE - CHARLOTTE, NC - CITY TOUR - CHRISTMAS MARKET After breakfast at the hotel and check-out, you will visit Mast General Store, a local landmark. The Original Mast General Store opened in 1883 in the rural community of Valle Crucis, North Carolina. Storekeepers tried to stock everything the community needed... from cradles to caskets. Today, Mast General Store boasts nine locations offering the same friendly and knowledgeable service that welcomed patrons to the original store. Even today, Mast General Store offers a variety of goods from fashion to fried chicken cookbooks and toffee to tents, not to mention a selection of hundreds of different kinds of candy! Following your visit to Mast General Store you will depart Asheville for Charlotte, North Carolina. Upon arrival, you will have time for lunch on your own before embarking on a guided tour of the city. Your local guide will share some of Charlotte's fascinating history and current happenings as you enjoy your tour of the historic 4th Ward neighborhood, Uptown Charlotte and the adjacent neighborhoods of South End, Dilworth and Myers Park. Later this afternoon you will check into the Holiday Inn Charlotte Airport Conference Center. This evening will put you in the holiday spirit as we visit one of Charlotte's Christmas Markets, filled with food, holiday drinks, festive music, and shopping. Deposit & Final Payment: Deposit of \$300 per person is due with Reservation Form to secure reservations. Final Payment Due Date is October 3, 2025.

Important General Information: The rate is based on a minimum of 30 paying participants.

Air Gateways: Roundtrip air transportation from your selected departure airport is included in the tour rate as listed.

Name Changes are not allowed. Each passenger cancellation is processed independently of any new passenger booking.

Hotels are subject to change.

Triple Rates: Triple room rate reduction is based on a standard double room with 2 beds. Triple rates do NOT include a third rollaway bed. Room configurations vary greatly Internationally.

Required Travel Documentation: For travel within the United States, a valid government issued photo identification will be required (ie. valid driver's license). Beginning May 2025, a Real ID will be required for air travel within the United States. A VALID PASSPORT BOOK is required for tours that leave the United States even to Canada and is the responsibility of each passenger. A passport card cannot be used for international air travel. Passport books should be valid for up to six (6) months beyond the return date of travel. All names must be submitted exactly as they appear on passenger passports. Dates of Birth (DOB's) are required with reservation for air travel. A clear and readable copy of passports is required. Additional forms may be necessary based on the destination.

Itinerary: Itinerary is subject to change. It's very common for the daily activities and people to people interactions & visits to be interchanged and experienced on different days than this printed itinerary. All visits and experiences will be included as written in this itinerary, but could be on different days due to availability and schedules.

Cancellation Policy & Fees: Regardless of reason, cancellations are subject to the following assessments: For cancellations from October 3 to October 31, 2025 a cancellation fee of \$300 will be assessed. For cancellations on November 1, 2025 through November 9, 2025, a cancellation fee of 50% of the tour cost will be assessed. For cancellations on November 10, 2025, or later, a cancellation fee of 100% of the tour cost will be assessed. No refund will be given for No Shows. Travel Protection Plans are available to cover penalties due to covered reasons.
