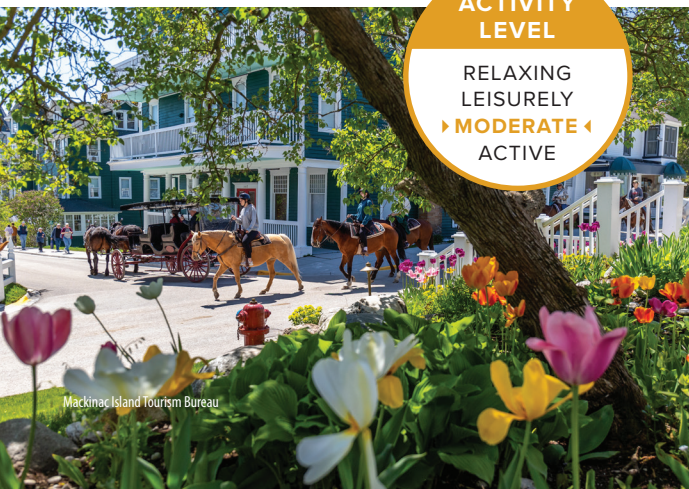

DAY 1: DEARBORN, MI - THE HENRY FORD MUSEUM - GREENFIELD VILLAGE - FRANKENMUTH, MI Upon arrival in Detroit, meet your Unique Journeys Tour Director. Depart for Dearborn, where you'll visit The Henry Ford Museum and Greenfield Village. This five-venue complex commemorates 300 years of the American experience. National treasures on display here include the Rosa Parks bus, presidential limousines, and a folding camp bed used by George Washington. DAY 4: MACKINAC ISLAND AT LEISURE A full American breakfast is included this morning in the Main Dining Room. Today is free for you to enjoy the many amenities and activities at the hotel, or browse the many unique galleries and shops in the village. Tonight, a five-course dinner is included again this evening in the Main Dining Room (dress code observed as outlined on Day 2). DAY 5: TRAVERSE CITY, MI - MUSIC HOUSE MUSEUM - SLEDER'S FAMILY TAVERN - PIERCE STOCKING SCENIC DRIVE - SLEEPING BEAR DUNES NATIONAL LAKESHORE A full American breakfast is included this morning in the Main Dining Room. Following breakfast and check out, we'll take a carriage ride to the dock and the early morning ferry back to the mainland and our waiting motorcoach. After boarding the motorcoach, depart for Traverse City. We will make a stop at the Music House Museum for a guided tour. The museum houses a one-of-a-kind collection of rare antique musical instruments and music-making machines, dating from 1870 through 1930. The tours demonstrate a Belgian dance organ, Wurlitzer Theater Organ, nickelodeons, and music boxes displayed in authentic period settings, and a unique musical gift shop. This afternoon, enjoy a delightful lunch at Sleder's Family Tavern. Established in 1882, this Traverse City landmark, is Michigan's oldest, and continuously operated restaurant.

Following lunch, we'll meet our local guide at the Philips A. Hart Visitor Center to begin the journey along the historic Pierce Stocking Scenic Drive, touring the Sleeping Bear Dunes National Lakeshore along Lake Michigan. High dunes afford spectacular views across the lake. An island lighthouse, U.S. Life-Saving Service stations, coastal villages, and picturesque farmsteads reflect the park's rich maritime, agricultural, and recreational history. The park is known as the "Most Beautiful Place in America" as voted by Good Morning America viewers. Tonight, check into the Park Place Hotel & Conference Center in Traverse City, MI. Enjoy the remainder of the evening at leisure and dinner on your own. 🍷 B, L 🏨 Park Place Hotel & Conference Center, Traverse City, MI

Important General Information: The rate is based on a minimum of 30 paying participants.

Air Gateways: Roundtrip air transportation – including air taxes, government fees & current fuel surcharges (subject to increase at the discretion of the airline) – is included in the tour rate as listed.

Name Changes are not allowed. Each passenger cancellation is processed independently of any new passenger booking.

Hotels are subject to change.

Triple Rates: Triple room rate reduction is based on a standard double room with 2 beds. Triple rates do NOT include a third rollaway bed.

Required Travel Documentation: For travel within the United States, beginning May 2025, a Real ID license or passport is required for air travel within the United States.

Itinerary: Itinerary is subject to change. It's very common for the daily activities and people to people interactions & visits to be interchanged and experienced on different days than this printed itinerary. 4. war or act of war, including invasion, acts of foreign enemies, hostilities between nations (whether declared or undeclared), or civil war;
